## **JOB TITLES & DESCRIPTIONS**

### **Interstate Gas Transmission**

#### **18 CFR Section 358.7(f)(1)**

#### **Senior Vice President & Chief Operating Officer**

Responsible for managing the operations, maintenance and commercial activities of FERC regulated interstate pipeline. Oversees the administration and application of information technologies and SCADA, the planning, organization and execution of various programs involving system development, the Integrity Management Program, Operational Budget and pipeline system optimization in addition to all commercial and business development activities.

#### **Senior Vice President Commercial Operations**

Responsible for budget development, management and staff development of Commercial Operations at American Midstream.

#### **Director, Commercial Operations**

Cross-functional position which consists of directing the contracting, invoicing, nominating, confirming and scheduling, gas control and field aspects of a natural gas pipeline system in a regulated environment. In addition, this position is responsible for maintaining customer contacts and assisting the Chief Operating Officer in the business development of the related assets.

#### **Director, Area Operations**

Responsible for supervision and coordination of the operations activities for American Midstream FERC regulated interstate pipelines. Assist the Senior Vice President of Operations with the planning, organization and execution of various programs involving system development, the Integrity Management Program, Operational Budget and pipeline system optimization.

#### **Contracts/Regulatory Administrator**

Responsible for the day to day commercial activities on American Midstream's FERC regulated, interstate pipelines. Duties include the negotiation and administration of transportation contracts, operational balancing agreements and interconnect agreements. Responsible for the responses to transportation service requests.

#### **Sr. Manager, Operations Accounting**

Oversees accounting functions for the American Midstream FERC regulated interstate pipelines and the monthly Transmission invoice process.

**Director, Commercial Services**

Oversees receipt and execution of nominations, scheduling, and allocations under transportation agreements, balancing agreement and interconnect agreements. Oversees day to day communication and coordination with shippers and interconnect operators in order to monitor and balance nominations for gas flow as well as receipts and deliveries.

**Gas Schedulers**

Responsible for the day to day receipt and execution of nominations, scheduling, and allocations under transportation agreements, balancing agreement and interconnect agreements; and day to day communications and coordination with shippers and interconnect operators in order to monitor and balance nominations for gas flow as well as receipts and deliveries.

**Manager, Gas Control & Measurement**

Oversees the monitoring and controlling of the pipeline systems to ensure sufficient operation pressures and volumes exist for safe and reliable operations based on shipper communicated requirements. Also fills System Controller function.

**Gas Controller, Senior Gas Controller, Lead Gas Controller, Crude Oil Controller, Senior Crude Oil Controller, Lead Crude Oil Controller**

Monitors and controls the FERC regulated interstate pipeline systems to ensure safe and reliable operations, maintain sufficient operating pressures and volumes based on shipper communicated requirements. Coordinates the daily activities of the pipelines between gas control and the commercial, nomination receipt, scheduling, customer service, field operations and engineering functions as well as with upstream and downstream producers, gatherers and pipelines.

**Commercial Analyst**

Responsible for tracking, reporting, analyzing and resolving customer service issues related to nominations, confirmation, scheduling, measurement, allocations, and invoicing aspects of a natural gas pipeline system in a regulated environment.
